## Where do we serve?

Our primary service territory for all services including financial and non-financial assistance is northern El Paso County in Colorado. These include the zip codes of 80132, 80133, 80840, 80921 and a large portion of 80908.

## Income Eligibility Guidelines

Eligibility for financial assistance is also based on the household income. If you fall within these guidelines, you may be eligible for help. Due various funding sources, assistance may vary based on these guidelines.

## What do you need to bring?

In order to receive assistance, please be sure to complete the application and bring the following items with you:

- Completed application
- Photo ID for all adults in the household (anyone 18 and over)
- Birth Certificates or SSN cards on elementary school age or younger; Student IDs for Middle and High School age
- Proof of residence (where you live) – This can be a current lease, a month-to-month lease or current mortgage statement
- Two consecutive months of current pay stubs for everyone who is working in the household
- Proof of non-work income such as Social Security award letters, pension letters, child support, unemployment benefits, etc.
- Two consecutive months of bank statements
- Current utility bill
- Award and/or denial letters for SNAP, Medicaid, TANF, LEAP or any other public assistance
