What areas does Tri-Lakes Cares serve?

What are the income guidelines?

Eligibility for financial assistance through Tri-Lakes Cares is based on household income. If your income is within the guidelines below, you may be eligible for financial assistance. Tri-Lakes Cares utilizes a variety of funding sources and assistance may vary based on these guidelines.

What documentation is required?

- **Proof of residence:** Lease agreement or mortgage statement and a utility bill with your name or the name of someone living in the household.
- **Proof of all the people living in the home:** Photo ID for all adults ages 18 and older, a Social Security card or birth certificate for anyone school age, and school IDs for middle and high school students.
- **Proof of income for all wage earners in the household who are age 18 and older:** Most recent paycheck stubs (last two months) and two months of bank statements. This may include proof of unemployment, award letters for SSI/SSDI and/or Social Security, and any additional documentation pertaining to retirement income.
- Applications for LEAP and SNAP (if eligible) are a required part of the financial assistance process. Please bring approval or denial letters for LEAP and/or SNAP to your appointment.
